



EXTRA-CURRICULAR POLICY STATEMENT

By invitation, children may participate in the extra-curricular activities which are offered by staff and members of the school community.

Parents/Carers of children wishing to participate in any activity which extends beyond the end of the school day must complete a form giving consent and outlining arrangements for the safe return home following the activity.

Children may not, **under any circumstances**, stay to any activity or take part in any games match away from school, unless a consent form has been signed by parents and returned to school.

Parents/Carers must inform the school in writing or by telephone if their child is unable to attend a particular session. In the event of an activity being cancelled in advance, parents will be notified in writing or by text message. If an activity has to be cancelled at short notice staff will endeavour to contact parents by text message or telephone. If no contact can be made, then children will be kept in school until contact is established or arrangements for safe home return are fulfilled.

If appropriate, there may be occasions when staff invite parents to attend extra-curricular activities with their children.

There is the expectation that, once enrolled in an activity, children will be committed to attending for the duration of the term.

Children who display inappropriate behaviour may lose the privilege to attend extra-curricular clubs.

'Under the terms of the governors' Charging Policy, voluntary contributions towards the cost of certain extra-curricular activities may be sought'.
