

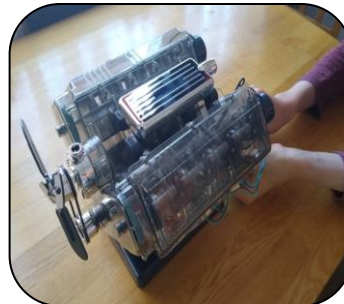


### End of Academic Year 2019/2020
